Specific topics include but are not limited to:

Style

Articles should be written in a simple and clear language, avoiding unnecessary jargon. The use of Pali or Sanskrit terms is sometimes necessary but it should be kept to a minimum.

Length

We do not have a standard word limit, but we encourage contributors to submit articles that have between 750 and 1500 words.

Citations

Sources should be cited in footnotes or noted in the text. Authors do not need to provide a bibliography.

AI-generated Text

We do not accept AI-generated material.

Biographical Data

Articles should include at the end two or three sentences about the author.
